



"School Finder is a fantastic tool that makes it easily accessible and helps make this Web site a reality," said Secretary of Education Dave Long. "This site will provide accurate and valuable school data in a clear and concise way that will empower parents to make meaningful decisions regarding the education of their children. I applaud the Governor for honoring his promise to parents and students in developing this site."

California School Finder is a new Web site that allows parents to easily find and compare schools side-by-side on data such as graduation rates and Academic Performance Index (API) scores. The site was developed by the Department of Education and then later fed into the Web site for elementary to high school and charter schools.

Governor Schwarzenegger directed his Secretary of Education to team up with Chief Information Officer Teri Takai to make this Web site a reality.


