WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION	<p>The single greatest danger to a project is a lack of or inadequate sponsorship. This four hour workshop prepares the participants to provide effective sponsorship to the projects in their portfolios by educating them regarding the role, responsibilities, and practices of effective project sponsors. This workshop will also provide an in depth discussion of the California Project Management Methodology (CA-PMM), the toolkits, and the sponsor's role in the development of relevant project management documents.</p>
