SUBJECT: **TRAVEL AND NON-ESSENTIAL TRAINING - NOVEMBER 4, 2011 MEMO AMENDMENT**

On November 4, 2011, you received a memo stating that reimbursement from the State Emergency Telephone Number Account (SETNA) to attend the CALNENA Annual Trade Show and Conference in San Diego on January 29-31, 2012 would not be approved by the California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Division.

Earlier this month, the CA 9-1-1 Division met with representatives of the California National Emergency Number Association (CALNENA) to discuss their request for reconsideration of this decision. After our conversations and reviewing additional information CALNENA provided, we have decided that the use of the CALNENA Annual Allotment (CAA) to attend the 2012 CALNENA Conference January 29 – 31 is permissible. **Therefore, this memo amends the previous CA 9-1-1 Division memo issued November 4, 2011.**
